




























#### **RLKU HOSTS SUCCESSFUL OPEN HOUSE FOR FALL ADMISSIONS 2025!**



This collaborative effort was highly appreciated, reflecting the shared commitment of both institutions to advancing medical education through innovation and capacity building.






#### **PATIENT WELFARE CLUB**
